Inter-County Match Rules:

Taken from Inter-County handbook rules.

A minimum of six players will constitute a team (Seniors). At least 6 players names must be entered on the match sheet for the first session (first 7 frames) before the start of play.

In the event of a County being short of a player then a blank space will be left in the number:

- Home Team: Number(s) 7
- Away Team: Number(s) 3

Players must keep the same player number throughout the match unless substituted by a reserve.

No player can be put on the match sheet, unless present. If a player is called, and does not appear he/she will lose that frame.
