NATIONAL LADIES KO CUP

Date Generally November each year

Participants Ladies Inter-league teams and Ladies Inter-County teams

Teams per County All ladies Inter-league teams and a maximum of two Inter-County

teams

Players 7 a-side plus 2 reserves allowed on each match sheet

Matches Teams to be allocated to a group to play all other teams in that

group. Top ranked teams in any group go forward to the

knock-out section

Draw Matches In the group stages a maximum of 14 frames can be played per

match. In the knock out section where a match is drawn, a three

frame play-off will decide which team progresses

Rules World 8 Ball

Team Qualification Teams must have competed at their Inter-County fixture or

Inter-League fixture in current year

Players Qualification A player must have played in 50% of her current Inter-

County/Inter-League fixtures by the date of the Final. Where a

player has less than the minimum required percentage dispensation must be sought in writing from the tournament

Director before the event starts

Format at Finals Start time 9am on the first day, usually Friday and concludes with

the final played on Saturday/Sunday. All knockout stage matches

will be played on a minimum of two tables (subject to best fit

practices for the event)

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
