CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

Format

Champion of Champions is:

Mens Singles Ladies Individual Championship 7 Person team Champions.

Entry to this event is open to all Leagues Affiliated to the English Pool Association.

Players do not have to be EPA ID registered members.

All Team entries must be submitted from Leagues and individual entrants must be authorised by an Official of the League.

Two (2) entries for each of the three (3) categories will be accepted from each league; the League Champions and the League Runners up.

Rules

Leagues must be registered with EPA by the 18th February of the year the final is to be played.

An enter by date will be set by the Sub-Committee of this event and an entry fee attached (entry fee covers all three (3) events).

A league not wishing to enter all three (3) categories should contact the Sub-Committee Chairman.

Champion of Champions finals are for current reigning league champions.

If the Individual Champion event, Ladies/Mens they must be amateur players. If the Champion is a professional then the next highest finishing amateur will be allowed to play in the Champion of Champions.

If the Leagues Champions do not wish to enter this event then the Runners up will be allowed.

Teams will be allowed to register ten (10) players.

Maximum of four (4) Professionals/Internationals can register, but only two (2) can play in a match.

Players may only enter this event once. (A team playing a player who has previously played with another team will be expelled).

A player may enter 2 events. (Play in the team event and play in the Individuals.)

Players must be eighteen (18) years old to enter this event.

Early round will be played within their own areas to minimise travel.

Playing rules will be World 8 Ball Pool Rules.

Entry forms must be accompanied with the Final League tables/knockout papers.

How To Enter

The League Secretary must return the relevant entry forms fully filled in with the players' details and the entry fee, to the Tournament Organiser before the official closing date.

Finals

The finals will be played over a weekend at Vauxhall Holiday Park. Great Yarmouth. First two (2) rounds of the Individual events will take place on the Friday night of the event.
